**WHEREAS**, each year in the United States, red light running results in nearly 200,000 crashes, more than 700 deaths; and

**WHEREAS**, in Arizona, over two dozen people lost their lives in intersection collisions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Red Means Stop Traffic Safety Alliance, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety, state, local, municipal, and national agencies are advocating for the awareness and prevention of red light running crashes.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Janice K. Brewer, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim March 2012 as

and encourage all residents to support the efforts of the Red Means Stop Traffic Safety Alliance and to do all they can to stop red light running.
